## PRESS RELEASE

The Polish Federation of Twinning Telecommunications invited the International Board of Directors of EUROJUMELAGES to hold a meeting in Cracow (Poland) on 8 and 9 September 2017. The meeting was chaired by Mr Marian Fabian.

The cooperation and preparation of the participants ensured that the proceedings were smooth and the meeting fruitful. The following decisions have been taken:

- Implementation of a development plan for new members from Eastern Europe and the Balkans;
- Approval of the schedule of intensive language courses for 2018 (Spanish, French, English, German, Polish and Portuguese) proposed by the member countries;
- Approval of the EUROJUMELAGES calendar of activities for 2018 and proposed by the member countries;
- Implementation of a stimulating process for young people and for summer jobs for young students;
- Presentation of the framework for the 12th EUROJUMELAGES International General Assembly to be held in Hendaye (France) in October 2019 (Accommodation conditions, reception at airports and railway station, philatelic exhibition and photographs, issuing of a personalized stamp, celebration of the 60th anniversary of the twinning movement in posts and telecommunications);
- Revitalization of the website with introduction of a membership form in several languages and better use of the Facebook page.

Subject to the cooperation of the Cypriot Telecommunications Association for Sports and Culture (CYTA), the next meeting of the Board of Directors of EUROJUMELAGES will take place from 6 to 9 September 2018 in Cyprus.
